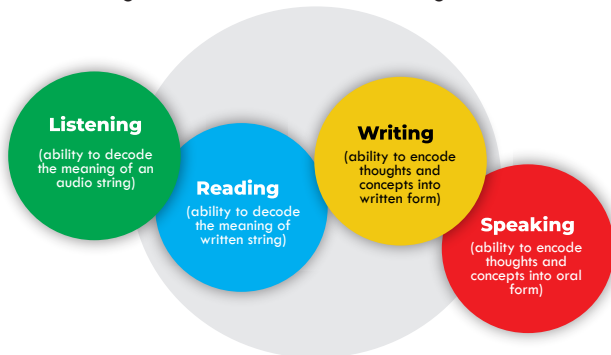

INTRODUCTION TO INTERNATIONAL LANGUAGES

Many definitions of language have been proposed. Henry Sweet, an English phonetician and language scholar, stated: 'Language is the expression of ideas by means of speech-sounds combined into words. Words are combined into sentences, this combination answering to that of ideas into thoughts.'

Competence in international languages enables people to communicate with others in different cultures, in a variety of settings, look beyond their customary borders, gain direct access to additional bodies of knowledge and participate fully in the global community and marketplace.



An internationally unquestioned position of international languages in international business, media, science, education, politics and diplomacy has spurred millions of people across the globe to want to learn international languages. What about you?

The American linguists Bernard Bloch and George L. Trager formulated the following definition:

“A language is a system of arbitrary vocal symbols by means of which a social group cooperates.”

Language is a system of conventional spoken, manual or written symbols by means of which human beings, as members of a social group can participate in its culture & express themselves.



The functions of a language include **communication, the expression of identity, play, imaginative expression and emotional release**

WHEN LEARNING A FOREIGN LANGUAGE...

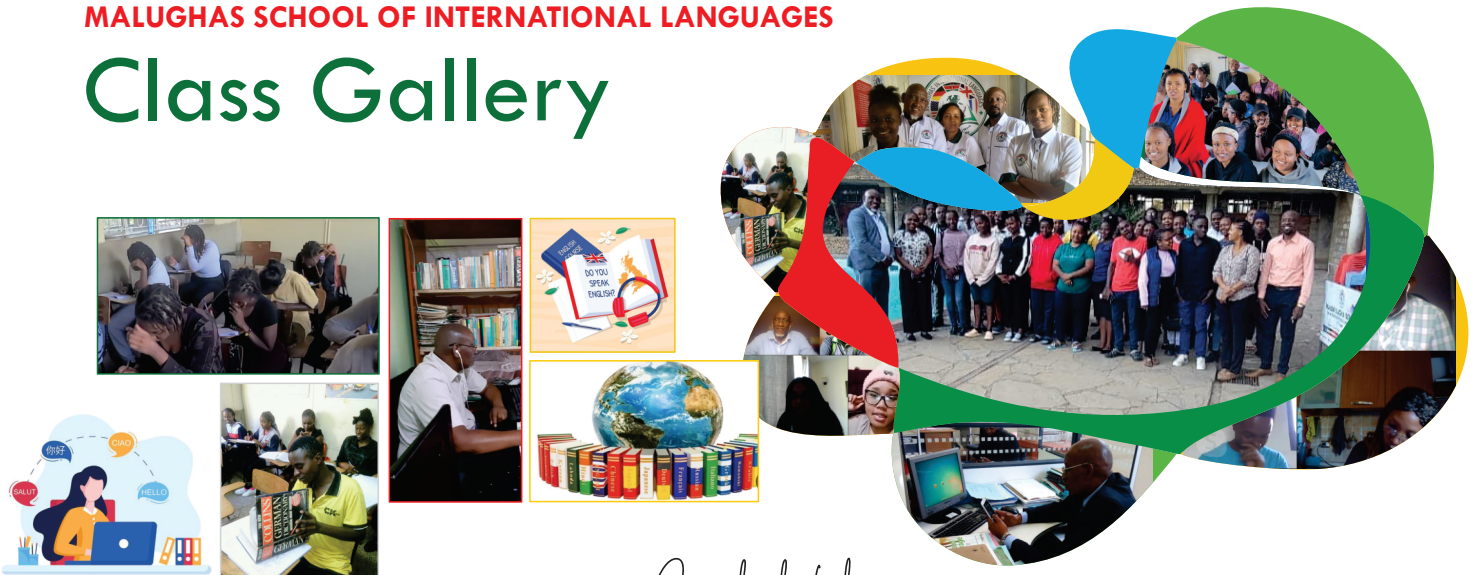
- > Read out loud. Don't worry about speed, focus on pronunciation accuracy.
- > Study vocabulary with flash cards. There is no quicker way to memorize all those new words.
- > Apply new grammar rules in practice exercises (more than once!) and do them over the next couple of days until you are able to recognize them instantly.
- > Practise, practise, practise, practise! Join a club, Whatsapp forum, Facebook group - any other language learning and practicing groups.
- > Seek and connect with international friends, especially for the language you are learning.
- > Watch movies, especially on Youtube and other such forums and even talk to yourself etc.

HOW TO REMEMBER WHAT YOU LEARN

- > Listen actively - write in your own words, connect to what you already know.
- > Pay attention and ask questions if something is not clear.
- > Review your notes after the lesson and try to quiz yourself to find out your comprehension of the subject matter.
- > Study a little before the next session and whenever you have an opportunity to do so.
- > Attempt relevant sample questions on the covered grammatical items. In case of poor performance seek further review of the poorly mastered grammatical points. Remember there is no understanding later with languages; ensure you understand before you continue with the next grammar points.
